'Dr Sarah Pye may be a writer, speaker and teacher, but that hasn't always been the case.

Sarah was born on a tiny British outpost on the Mediterranean called Gibraltar, then spent the summers of her first decade plying the waters of the Norfolk broads aboard a classic wooden boat. (Think *Swallows and Amazons*).

When she was 13, Sarah's teacher parents moved their family onto a 30ft sea-going ketch. She was boat-schooled by the world around her – holding night watches, grocery shopping in foreign ports, and hunkering down in ranging storms.

At 17, Sarah left her floating home for college in the United States. She obtained her commercial captain's license before she could drive a car. Then, with a hospitality management degree under her arm, continued her westward migration to Hawaii, and on to Australia's Whitsunday Islands. Sarah's business, [Ocean Rafting](#), was awarded the Queensland Tourism Award for Best Adventure Product in 2001.

Sarah published her first book, a guidebook called ***Kids Welcome to Queensland***, in 2009. The resulting travel business led to Sarah being named [Sunshine Coast Small Business Woman of the Year](#) in 2010.

A trip to Borneo with her daughter in 2012 changed the trajectory of Sarah's life once again, when she met Malaysian ecologist, Wong Siew Te. Sarah asked how she could help Wong save sun bears from extinction. He replied:

'Do what you do best'.

For the last 14 years, Sarah has done just that: Creating a sun bear adoption program which helps raise money for conservation, writing Wong's biography as her Doctor of Creative Arts Degree, writing six children's books about his adventures in the jungle, running an online monthly event for wildlife lovers around the world, and conducting workshops (nationally and internationally) which reconnect all ages with nature.

Sarah hopes there are many more adventures to come. Starting in mid-2027, she will hit the road in her camper, *Wombat*, meeting readers and conducting workshops along the way!

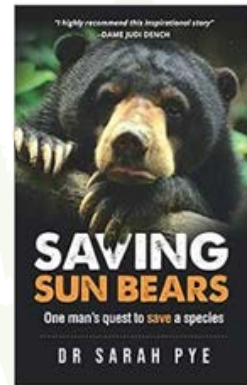

The first book in the Wildlife Wong series for 8-12 year-olds was an award-winning finalist in the Children's Non-Fiction category of the 2021 International Book Awards.



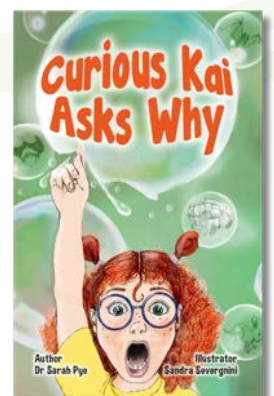
The Wildlife Wong series (6 books)

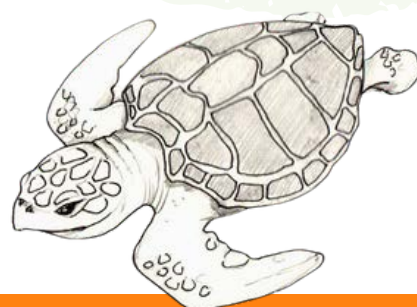

WHAT SORT OF ANIMAL AM I ?

Suitability: Prep and lower primary

Students learn about some of the incredible animals in Sarah's books through storytelling, puppetry and a multimedia presentation. They then embrace their 'inner animal' and colour an animal mask to take home. The focus can be on Australian, or Bornean species.

THE COOLEST ANIMALS YOU NEVER KNEW EXISTED

Suitability: Prep and lower primary

This workshop starts with a multimedia presentation introducing some of the coolest rainforest animals on earth. Then students become part of the action: using puppets to act out a story from *Wildlife Wong and the Fig Wasp*.

TRAVEL

For road travel, the first 100km return from the Sunshine Coast, Queensland is included. Additional driving is billed at \$1 per kilometre.

RAINFOREST IN A JAR

Suitable for: Primary
Not suitable for: International tours

Did you know the oldest terrarium in the world was built in 1960? Sarah uses a multimedia presentation to explain how a rainforest system works, and explore themes of biodiversity. Then students make their very own rainforest in a jar to take home.

☞ *Pitched really well to the age of the cohort. Great information that tied in so well to our Unit of Inquiry on Sharing the Planet. The making of the terrarium allowed the children to understand the layers of the rainforest and of course they got to take them home.*



SCIENCE STORYTELLING: FACT OR FICTION?

Suitability: Upper primary

Sarah uses her books to explore the differences between nonfiction and fiction; narratives and informational text. Students learn the importance of research, planning and editing, and add tools to their own writing toolbox. They even get to help Sarah research her next book!

☞ *Getting into how you go about writing your book and planning was fantastic. After you left, many students went back to evaluate their own planning for their stories, which was GREAT!*

THE PARLIAMENT OF ANIMALS



This exploration of civics and stewardship is suitable for one class or a group of student leaders.

Hypothetical developers propose a monorail development. The mayor (Sarah) calls a town meeting and invites human and non-human residents.

Students are allocated a character, research their character's needs, then present their perspective at the town gathering before voting for or against the monorail.

The day ends with a discussion of civics and Australian democracy.

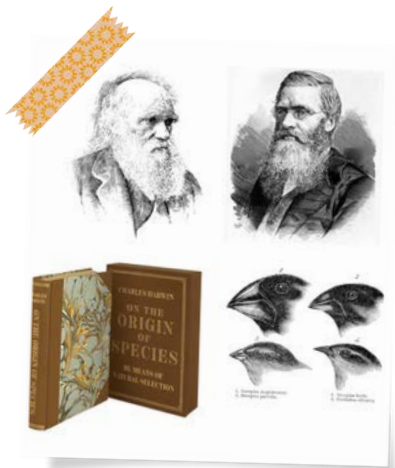
